

An Open Badge is an instrument that makes visible (and actionable) information about the experiences, achievements, practices, skills, commitments, values or aspirations of an individual, community (of practice) or organisation. By making visible (in an open format, free of rights and under the control of their "owners") information that was previously inaccessible, open badges facilitate the emergence of recognition eco-systems that promote learning, employment and social inclusion.

Open Recognition



In 2016, a new coalition of learning stakeholders issued the **Bologna Open Recognition Declaration**: a call for a universal open architecture for the recognition of lifelong and lifewide learning achievements.


Open Badges, the open standard for the recognition of learning achievements has proved the power of a simple, affordable, resilient and trustworthy technology to create an open recognition ecosystem working across countries, educational sectors, work, social environments and technologies.
